

## A geographical distribution


Developer Nation Community split per Region



# LCNC tools are very popular among GenAl Application Developers

75% of developers who build generative AI applications use low-code or no-code (LC/NC) tools in their workflows. (n=16,500 25th Developer Nation survey)

### Adoption of low-code / no-code tools



# The rise of low-code / no-code development platforms

Low-code / no-code (LCNC) tools provide a visual approach to software development by automating parts of the application development process. These solutions allow developers, even without prior software development experience, to easily build applications, leading to potential time and cost efficiencies. To understand how the adoption of LCNC tools has evolved over the past 18 months, we draw data and insights from SlashData Q1 2022 and Q3 2023 global developer surveys. This begs the question, to what extent are developers using LCNC tools for their development projects?

# Usage of Low-Code No-Code tools in development projects

Over the past 18 months, the percentage of developers using LCNC tools in their projects has substantially increased, from 46% to 57%. Furthermore, 32% report using these tools for at least a quarter of their development work as of Q3 2023 (up from 26% in Q1 2022). This suggests that not only are LCNC tools becoming more popular amongst developers, but a significant proportion of them are incorporating them in




